**If you don't meet the posting qualifications and are interested in this position:*

To be considered for open competitive eligibility for the title of Highway Maintainer, you must be deemed qualified by Central Management Services (CMS). Highway Maintainer is a regularly tested title that requires an automated multiple-choice test to be taken at one of the CMS Assessment Centers. After successfully obtaining a passing grade, your name will be placed on an open competitive eligible list for Highway Maintainer in the two counties you select on your application. If you are satisfied with the grade you received for this title, option and county, no further action is required. Your name has already been placed on the open competitive eligible list for this title. Open competitive grades are valid for one (1) year.
