Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, construction work on IL 40 from Sterling to Milledgeville will begin on Monday, June 6, 2016. Civil Constructors is starting the \$3.7 million project to improve the 12 mile section of IL 40 from Lynn Boulevard at the north edge of Sterling to Adams Street in Milledgeville. The project is scheduled to be completed by mid-September.

Improvements will include milling off some sections of the existing bituminous overlays, making pavement repairs, and resurfacing the roadway. Traffic will be restricted to one lane as roadway repairs are completed. Drivers should be prepared to stop and should be alert for flaggers who will be directing traffic past the work operations.
