IDOT: Road Closure at IL Route 120 & CN Railroad in Grayslake August 4

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that repairs to the railroad grade crossing at IL Route 120 and the Canadian National Railroad (CN RR) in the Village of Grayslake, will begin Monday, August 4, 2014.


In order to safely perform the work, it will be necessary to close IL Route 120 just west of IL Route 83 beginning at 6 a.m. Monday until 6 p.m. Wednesday, August 13.

The posted detour route for eastbound traffic on IL Route 120 will be to proceed southbound on Alleghany Road to eastbound on Peterson Road, northbound on IL Route 83 back to IL Route 120. The posted detour route for westbound traffic on IL Route 120 will be to proceed southbound on IL Route 83, westbound on Peterson Road, northbound on Alleghany Road back to IL Route 120.

Motorists can expect delays during times when the road closures are in effect and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signing in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
