IDOT: Lane Closures on US 20 over McLean Boulevard in Elgin Today Through April 23

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that as part of the on-going intersection reconstruction and bridge replacement project at US 20 over McLean Boulevard in Elgin, lane closures will occur today, Monday, April 14, 2014 through Wednesday, April 23, 2014.

Monday, 4/14 - Tuesday, 4/22 - Lanes closures on NB McLean – 7 a.m. - 4 p.m.

Friday, 4/18 - Ramp traffic switch – Beginning at 1 p.m., existing westbound US 20 on/off ramps at McLean will be switched to the new constructed ramps.

Wednesday, 4/23- Lane closure on SB McLean – 7 a.m. - 4 p.m.

Motorists can expect delays during times when the lane closures are in effect and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signing in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
