# IDOT: Lane Closures on NB I-57 at Cal Sag Bridge in Blue Island Tonight

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that weather permitting, a traffic switch on northbound I-57 over the Cal Sag Bridge in the City of Blue Island, will occur Monday night, June 2, 2014.

Traffic will be switched NB and will be in place for the morning rush on Tuesday, June 3rd. Southbound will be switched on Tuesday night, June 3<sup>rd</sup> and will be in place for the morning rush on Wednesday, June 4th. The switch is necessary to perform work on the right lane (lane 3) and the outside shoulder of NB I-57 over the Cal Sag Bridge.


Additional lanes may need to be closed at night, however two lanes NB and SB will remain open to traffic during peak traffic hours. All lanes will reopen to traffic in late summer 2014.

The following alternate routes will be posted:

Northbound I-57 traffic should exit at west 159<sup>th</sup> Street. Take 159<sup>th</sup> to Cicero Avenue, travel north to 127<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn east on 127<sup>th</sup> and follow to the I-57 northbound entrance.

Southbound I-57 traffic should exit west 127<sup>th</sup> to Cicero, travel south on Cicero to 159<sup>th</sup>. Turn east on 159<sup>th</sup> and follow to the I-57 southbound entrance.

Motorists can expect delays during times when the lane closures are in effect and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signing in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
