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IL 170 Closed South of US 6 in Seneca

(Culverts Reconstructed on IL 170)

Ottawa, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that beginning Monday, June 2, 2014, IL 170 will be closed to through traffic, 6.0 miles south of U.S. 6 in Seneca, to allow for reconstruction of 3 box culverts.

A \$1,258,669.80 contract has been awarded to "D" Construction, Inc., of Coal City, IL, for the work which consists of replacement of the 3 box culverts, installation of guardrail items and minor resurfacing. Traffic on IL 170 will be detoured during construction. The detour will utilize C.H. 39 (Ransom Blacktop) and C.H. 6 (Grand Ridge Mazon Blacktop). It is anticipated that IL 170 will be open to traffic on August 15, 2014. Additional work may be done after this date, but it will be performed using flaggers.

Motorists are urged to use extreme caution when traveling around and through the work zone and to be alert for flaggers and all other workers.


