
## **Wabash Avenue Construction**

Springfield, Illinois - The Illinois Department of Transportation announces construction will begin, weather permitting, on March 17, 2014 on Wabash Avenue in Springfield, Illinois. The projects limits on Wabash Avenue are from west of Robbins Road to MacArthur Boulevard. The project consists of 2.15 miles of hot-mix asphalt resurfacing, pavement patching, concrete median removal and replacement, traffic signal improvements, pavement striping, sidewalk ramps, and other associated roadway improvements.

All work except the traffic signal improvements should be completed by July 2014. The traffic signal improvements require a long lead time for delivery of electrical materials and therefore may not be completed until the early fall of 2014.

The contractor for this \$3,600,000 project is P.H. Broughton & Sons, Inc. of Springfield, Illinois.

Motorists are urged to slow down and use extreme caution while driving through this construction site and all work zones.
