Location – I-64/55 Eastbound Collector/Distributor

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that daily lane closures will be encountered on the I-64/55 Eastbound Collector/Distributor between the Tudor-Piggot Entrance Ramp and Barack Obama Avenue beginning **Monday, June 2, 2014**.

The right lane will be closed daily at 6:00 a.m. and will be reopened by 3:00 p.m.

Traffic will be guided through the work zone utilizing flaggers, traffic control devices, and traffic control signing. Please use extreme caution while traveling through the work zone. This lane closure is necessary to resurface the existing pavement.

All work should be completed by **Thursday, June 5, 2014**, weather permitting.
