TOWNSHIP BRIDGE PROGRAM

COUNTY ENGINEERS / SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS

Attached is a list of counties with their FY 2021 Township Bridge Program (TBP) allotment of the \$15 million, as authorized by the General Assembly, to be used by the road districts for the construction of bridges.

Any unused FY 2021 TBP funds will lapse four years from the date this Circular Letter (August 31, 2024). Unused FY 2020 TBP funds will lapse September 3, 2023. Unused FY 2019 TBP funds will lapse on August 14, 2022. Unused FY 2018 TBP funds will lapse on August 30, 2021. Unused FY 2017 TBP funds lapsed on August 25, 2020. The oldest funds should be used first.

Please submit your FY 2021 Township Bridge Program to your district office by September 30, 2020 or as directed by your district. Utilize form BLR 09210 for your submittals and provide all information as indicated.
