TOWNSHIP BRIDGE PROGRAM

COUNTY ENGINEERS/SUPERINTENDENTS OF HIGHWAYS

Attached is a list of counties with their FY 2009 Township Bridge Program allotments of the \$15 million as authorized by the General Assembly to be used by the road districts for construction of bridges.

The unused FY 2009 Township Bridge Program funds will lapse two years from the date of this letter. The two-year obligation period also applies to currently unused FY 2008 funds. Consequently, the FY 2008 funds will lapse on August 29, 2009.

Please submit your FY 2009 Township Bridge Program to your district office by September 15, 2008 or as directed by your district. Utilize form BLR 09210 for your submittals and provide all information as indicated. If participation in preliminary engineering is desired, it should be included as a separate project.
