Illinois Highway, Aviation, Rail, Transit and Marine Systems

- **Population** – 12.8 million
- **Licensed drivers** – 9.16 million
- **Total vehicle registrations** – 11.66 million
- **Annual vehicle miles of travel in Illinois** – 108 billion
- **Annual gallons of fuel consumed** – 6.4 billion
- **Miles of road** – 147,005 centerline miles throughout the state
- **Miles under state jurisdiction** – 15,908
- **Miles plowed by snow removal crews** – 44,181
- **Rest areas** – 30
- **Public use aviation landing facilities** – 110
- **Registered aircraft** – 7,900
- **Registered pilots** – 15,582
- **Bridges** – 7,852 bridges under state jurisdiction
- **Railroad grade crossings** – 10,363, with 7,651 public crossings and 3,649 private crossings, the second-highest total in the United States
- **Transit systems** – 60 throughout the state, operating in 96 of the 102 counties in Illinois
- **Transit passenger trips** – 632.5 million annually
- **Amtrak annual ridership** – 4.6 million riders at Illinois stations
- **Seat belt usage in Illinois** – 93.8 percent for front-seat occupants in 2016
- **Annual traffic deaths** – 1,080 (provisional) in 2017
- **Inland navigable waterways** – Mississippi, Ohio, Kaskaskia and Illinois rivers, including the Chicago Area Waterway System
- **Miles of navigable waterways** – 1,118
- **River locks** – 28
- **Marine Terminals** – Approximately 350
