IL47 Improvement Study

Purpose of Today's Meeting

Need for the Study

- Existing roadway is at or near capacity and traffic is projected to increase
- Crash data indicates congestion
- Regional growth creates demand
- Existing features may not be adequate for expected traffic

Proposed Schedule

- The Phase 1 preliminary engineering study (\$1.4 million) is scheduled for completion during the summer of 2012
- The Phase 2 preliminary engineering design (\$1.35 million programmed) for the portion of the project inside Kendall County will begin after completion of the Phase 1 study and is anticipated to take 24 months
- Land acquisition and construction phases are unfunded in the current Proposed Highway Improvement Program
