

INTRODUCTION

The 2023 Illinois Travel Statistics publication is assembled to provide detailed traffic information to the different users of traffic data. While most users of traffic data at this level of detail are within the Illinois Department of Transportation, this publication is also being made available outside the Department.

The current 2023 Illinois Travel Statistics publication in addition to previous years of the publication going back the last 10 years can be viewed and downloaded from the IDOT web site, http://www.idot.illinois.gov/transportation-system/Network-Overview/highway-system/illinois-travel-statistics.

In 2005, nineteen counties were moved to different Districts as part of IDOT's overall reorganization plan. During 2006, three counties were moved from District 9 to District 7. Any comparison of District data between years needs to take into consideration the revised District boundaries.

Annual Average Daily Traffic volumes (AADT) and Vehicle Miles of Travel (VMT) are products of IDOT's Traffic Count Program. Counts from this program range in duration from data continuously recorded at permanent count stations to thousands of coverage count locations that are counted for either a 24-hour or 48-hour period throughout the year. The mileage and vehicle miles of travel data in the following tables are based on roads and streets located within the Districts geographical boundaries (Administrative District). In this report, the State System consists of state-maintained highways including highways marked as Interstate routes, United States routes or Illinois State routes.

Vehicle Miles of Travel (VMT) are calculated by multiplying the centerline mileage times the AADT from the Illinois Highway Information System. VMT data is expressed as either Daily Vehicle Miles of Travel (DVMT) or as Annual Vehicle Miles of Travel (AVMT).

The term "Urban" denotes mileage within urban clusters as designated by the Bureau of Census having a population of 5,000 or more. Urban areas may include any adjacent areas that have or are developing urban characteristics. The term "rural" consists of those miles located outside an urban area. An urbanized area consists of an incorporated place and adjacent densely settled area that together have a minimum population of 50,000.


