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PEORIA – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that eastbound and westbound I-74 traffic between I-155 and I-474 will be shifted to new pavement beginning at 5:30 p.m. Friday, November 1st and continuing through 6:30 a.m. Monday, November 4th.

The traffic shift necessary is to allow for the reconstruction of the eastbound and westbound lanes of I-74. Traffic will remain in this configuration until December. The following lane closures will be necessary to facilitate the traffic stage change:

- Eastbound I-74 left lane and westbound I-74 left lane
 - 5:30 p.m. Friday, November 1st through 6:30 a.m. Monday, November 4th

The lane closures are likely to result in significant delays and traffic backups.

The overall project is the complete reconstruction of I-74 from Pleasant Hill Road to Morton Avenue in Tazewell County, including construction of additional through lanes on I-74; reconstruction of the I-155 interchange into a new configuration; ramp improvements at the Morton Avenue interchange; removal of eight existing structures on I-74 with replacement of six of those structures; pavement removal and replacement; installation of highway lighting; and, installation of roadway drainage. The project is expected to be completed in 2015.
