## **Job Responsibilities**

30%

1. In the performance of duties, operates CDL Class A licensed vehicles such as maintenance trucks, backhoes, loaders, motorboat, and tractors.
  - Operates specialized hydraulic boom and platform equipment to place inspectors on or along pier caps and under bridge decks to conduct inspections.
  - Statewide travel with overnight stays.

30%

2. Assists lead worker in maintaining specialized equipment including repairs, maintenance, and adjustments.
  - Performs routine maintenance and minor repairs and arranges for other services as directed by the lead worker and in coordination with the bureau's purchasing/invoicing designee.
  - Completes the necessary forms and reports relating to equipment operations and maintenance.

25%

3. Performs other duties as assigned by the lead worker when engaged in bridge inspection and related activities.
  - Operates a boat for underwater inspections, operates a manlift for fracture critical inspections, and installs scaffolding.

10%

4. During snow and ice conditions, operates snowplows and spreads salt and sand.
  - Plows and removes snow.
  - Responds to emergency weather situations, as instructed verbally or in writing, to inspect roadways and remove hazardous material/obstacles, some weighing up to 50 pounds, from roadways and drainage areas.

5. Performs other duties as required or assigned which are reasonably within the scope of those enumerated above.

## **Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities**

### **Minimum Qualifications**

1. Requires knowledge, skill and mental development equivalent to the completion of four years of high school.
2. Requires possession of a Class "A" CDL with appropriate endorsements, to include X or N and no airbrake restrictions.
3. For seasonal employees only, possession of a Class B CDL with appropriate endorsements, to include X or N and no airbrake restrictions, is acceptable for a period of two years. At the beginning of the third year from the initial hire date, a seasonal employee must possess a Class A CDL.
4. Requires one year driving experience immediately preceding appointment free of incidents which could result in license suspension or revocation.

### **Preferred Qualifications**

1. Prefers experience operating snowplows.
2. Prefers ability and skill to operate a variety of heavy equipment as well as general mechanical, diesel, and gasoline engines knowledge. Equipment to be operated - special hydraulic boom equipment, trucks, trailers, high lifts, and motorboats.
3. Prefers experience maintaining bridges.
4. Prefers experience maintaining roadsides.
5. Prefers certified welder.

## **Conditions of Employment**

1. Requires successful completion of a background investigation.
2. Requires the ability to perform arduous labor.
3. Requires the ability to work under adverse weather conditions.
4. Requires the ability to lift up to 50 pounds.
5. Requires the ability to work in confined spaces, climb steep terrain, and wade in water.
6. Requires the ability to deal with poisonous plants, animals, insects, rodents, and snakes.
7. Requires the ability to perform outdoor work in a variety of conditions including, but not limited to, hot, cold, wet, windy, muddy, active constructions sites, and roadways open to traffic.
8. Requires the ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions.
9. Requires the ability to maintain productive working relationships.

10. Operations employees are subject to call at any hour of the day or night on any day of the year.
11. Occasionally, the department is required to respond to emergencies outside normal work hours. As a result, negotiated rate employees are required to work reasonable amounts of overtime when necessary.
12. Any bargaining unit employee who may be required to engage in a call out shall respond to the call as quickly as practicable but in no situation can the response time exceed forty-five minutes.
