
Vision Zero is both the City of Chicago's commitment to and the approach to eliminating death and serious injury from traffic crashes.

- Data analysis
- Identification of current and needed resources
- A Citywide plan with a community focus

VISION ZERO HIGH CRASH AREAS & CORRIDORS



RAPID DELIVERY PROJECTS

Low -cost, “quick -hit” changes to the street using interim materials:

- Pavement markings
- Colored pavement treatments
- Flexible delineators
- Changes to signage or signal timing


