Resurfacing Project on Dundee Road from Potowatami Wood Forest Preserve to I-94/U.S. 41

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that daily lane closures will take place on Dundee Road (Illinois 68) from the Potowatami Wood Forest Preserve to Interstate 94/U.S. 41, in Wheeling and Northfield, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, May 9. The closures are necessary for a resurfacing project along Dundee Road.

In order to complete the work, temporary lane closures will take place on Dundee Road between the entrance to the Potowatami Wood Forest and Interstate 94/U.S. 41. Dundee Road will be reduced to one lane in each direction, when necessary.

The scope of the project includes roadway resurfacing and improvements to drainage and pedestrian safety. The project is expected to be completed in Fall 2016.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
