Work to Resume on I-74 in Vermilion County

PARIS – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that work will resume Monday, March 14 on Interstate 74 from Illinois Route 49 to U.S. 150 near Danville (MM 200-215).

The remaining work on this project will include approximately five miles of pavement patching, milling and HMA resurfacing on mainline Interstate 74 on the western half of the project. Also included: shoulder work along the entire project, pavement marking, raised reflective marker placement, shoulder rumble strip placement, wing wall repair, and erosion control placement.

With the exception of traffic control set up and other minor items, the work will be done at night. Lanes will remain closed during the day to facilitate the night work.

The overall project has an anticipated completion date of June 30, weather permitting. The contractor for the \$13,138,522 project is Open Road Paving.
