## 106<sup>th</sup> Street closing at rail crossing April 25

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that repairs to the Belt Railroad Company of Chicago crossing on 106<sup>th</sup> Street, east of Torrence Avenue, in Chicago will require a full closure starting, weather permitting, 6 a.m. Saturday, April 25.

A posted detour will direct motorists to Torrence Avenue, 100<sup>th</sup> Street, Commercial Avenue and Muskegon Avenue.

The work is expected to be complete by 7 a.m. Sunday, May 3.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to detour signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
