OTTAWA, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that the IL 9 and 47-Illinois Central Railroad Company grade crossing in Gibson City will be closed on Monday, September 14, 2020. IL 9 and 47 will be closed for approximately 14 days to allow the Illinois Central Railroad to rebuild their grade crossing. IL 9 and 47 traffic will proceed as follows:

IL 9 westbound and IL 47 northbound traffic will proceed north on Sangamon Avenue to Eighth Street; thence west on Eighth Street back to IL 9 and 47.

IL 9 eastbound and IL 47 southbound traffic will proceed east on Eighth Street to Sangamon Avenue; thence south on Sangamon Avenue back to IL 9 and 47.

Motorists are urged to use caution and expect some delays while traveling the detour route. Please slow down and use extreme caution while driving through all work zones.
