Old US 66 Pavement Rehabilitation to Begin September 14

Bloomington – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that work will begin Monday, September 14, 2020 on Old US 66 in McLean County.

Work will include patching, pavement milling and placing new HMA surface on Old US 66 from Fox Creek Road southwest of Bloomington to Shirley. Intermittent lane closures are necessary for crews to perform the repairs to the pavement. One lane in each direction will remain open at all times during this work which is expected to last through the end of October.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
