## **PRESS RELEASE**

### *Interstate 270, Granite City, Illinois, Madison County*

Granite City, Illinois – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces lane restrictions on I-270, just west of the IL 3 interchange in Granite City, beginning Thursday, December 2, 2021, at 6:00 AM for eastbound traffic and 9:00 AM for westbound traffic, weather permitting. All lanes will be open as soon as possible.

These restrictions are needed to make repairs to traffic data collection sensors in the pavement. Wissehr Electric is making the needed repairs.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
