## **Illinois 94 to close April 5 for bridge repair**

**QUINCY** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that Illinois 94 south of Golden in Adams County will close on Tuesday, April 5.

The closure is necessary for replacement of the railroad bridge. A detour directing traffic onto U.S. 24, County Highway 11 and County Highway 17 will be posted. Work is expected to be completed by Thursday, April 7.

No traffic will be permitted on Illinois 94 between County Road N 2300 and N 2200 Avenue, and motorists are encouraged to follow the posted detour and should allow for extra travel time. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
