100th Street in Chicago closing at rail crossing May 9

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that repairs to the Chicago Rail Link, LLC crossing on 100th Street, east of Torrence Avenue, in Chicago, will require a full closure starting, weather permitting, 9 a.m. Monday, May 9.

A detour will direct motorists to Torrence Avenue, 106th Street, Muskegon Avenue and Commercial Avenue.

The work is expected to be complete by, weather permitting, 7 a.m. Friday, May 20.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to detour signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
