Selmaville Road over Crooked Creek, 3.25 miles south of US 50 in Marion County

Salem – The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that Selmaville Road over Crooked Creek, 3.25 miles south of US 50 in Marion County will be closed to all traffic beginning Tuesday, September 6, 2022, weather permitting. This work is necessary to repair the existing structure. Selmaville Road is expected to be reopened in early November 2022.

Motorists will need to find an alternate route during this closure. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to construction signage and watch for changing conditions, obey the posted speed limits, and refrain from using mobile devices.

The contractor on this project is Depew and Owen Builders, Inc. of Centralia, Illinois.
