Shermer Road resurfacing begins Aug. 22

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that a resurfacing of Shermer Road, from Old Willow Road to Willow Road, in Northbrook and Glenview, will require intermittent daytime lane closures beginning, weather permitting, Monday, Aug. 22.

Work will also consist of constructing new ADA-compliant sidewalk ramps, along with pavement repairs and replacing deteriorated curbs on Milwaukee Avenue (Illinois 21), just north of Sanders Road. Access to residences and businesses within the work zone will be maintained throughout construction, anticipated to be completed in early November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 2,500 miles of highway and nearly 10 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Three of Rebuild Illinois included approximately \$8.6 billion of improvements statewide on 4,422 miles of highway, 412 bridges, and 621 additional safety improvements.
