US 67 Centennial Bridge Repairs to Begin In Rock Island County August 18

Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today, weather permitting, construction will begin Wednesday, August 18th, 2022, on the US 67 Centennial Bridge over the Mississippi River. White Construction, LLC will begin structural steel repairs to the \$1,458,043.10 project. The bridge will be reduced to one lane in each direction utilizing the northbound lanes for traffic with the southbound lanes closed to complete the repairs. The southbound repairs will take approximately two to three weeks to complete at which point traffic will be shifted to the southbound lanes to complete the repairs in the northbound lanes. Pedestrian traffic across the bridge will not be affected.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
