## I-290 ramp to Biesterfield Road improvements

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that a project to improve the exit ramp from northbound Interstate 290 to Biesterfield Road (Illinois 53), in Elk Grove Village, will require lane closures beginning, weather permitting, Monday, Aug. 1.

The \$1.7 million project involves reconstructing and widening the existing exit ramp, adding an additional dedicated right turn lane, installing new modernized traffic signals and resurfacing.

At least one lane will remain open throughout construction, anticipated to be completed in spring 2023.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,535 miles of highway and nine million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Two included approximately \$5.2 billion of improvements statewide on 3,020 miles of highway, 270 bridges and 428 additional safety improvements.
