HOT MIX ASPHALT RESURFACING
IL 34
CITY of HARRISBURG
SALINE COUNTY

CARBONDALE-The Illinois Department of Transportation is alerting motorists traveling on IL 34 in Harrisburg of the construction project beginning at 7 a.m. Monday, August 1, weather permitting. Traffic will be reduced to one lane and controlled by flaggers. The work on IL 34 is from Old IL 13 (Poplar Street) to the levee just north of Reservoir Road in Harrisburg.

The project includes pavement patching, hot mix asphalt removal, hot mix asphalt paving, pavement markings and the resurfacing of the parking lanes. The work is expected to last until September 30.

Motorists should obey flaggers, reduce speed, be alert for equipment and workers and use extreme caution while traveling through all work zones.

To avoid any delays, motorists should seek an alternate route. Emergency vehicles will be allowed through the work zone as quickly as possible.
