## I-39 bridge project begins July 11

**MINONK** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced a bridge-repair project that will close three roads over Interstate 39 between Minonk and Wenona beginning July 11.

The road closures are at:

- Township Road 2100N at Minonk in Woodford County
- County Road 4 and Township Road 200N, both in Marshall County

Detours for each road will be posted during the project, which is expected to be complete in late August.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,500 miles of highway and 9 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Two included approximately \$5.2 billion of improvements statewide on 3,020 miles of highway, 270 bridges and 428 additional safety improvements.
