UPDATE: Interstate 255 NB in Collinsville, Madison County

Collinsville, Illinois – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces lane restrictions will be encountered Monday, August 1, 2022, until Friday, August 5, 2022, on northbound I-255 over Horseshoe Lake Road (Exit 26) in Collinsville. Weather permitting, the right two lanes and the deceleration lane to Horseshoe Lake Road on northbound I-255 will be closed daily between 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Nightly, the far-right lane and the deceleration lane to Horseshoe Lake Road will remain closed. All lanes are expected to be open by 9:00 a.m. on Friday, August 5, 2022. The exit ramp from I-255 to Horseshoe Lake Road will remain open during construction.

These restrictions are needed to do emergency bridge deck patching on the bridge carrying I-255 northbound over Horseshoe Lake Road. IDOT District 8 Operations forces will make the needed improvements. Full access will be restored as soon as possible.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
