Centennial Bridge inspection in Rock Island begins July 18

DIXON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that, weather permitting, there will be a lane closure on the U.S. 67 Mississippi River bridge (Centennial Bridge) in Rock Island beginning Monday, July 18, for bridge inspections.

The southbound right lane will be closed on the bridge from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily. Signing will be utilized to maintain traffic during the project, which is scheduled to be completed by 3 p.m. Friday, July 22.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
