## **Harrison Road over Sugar River to close July 25**

**DIXON** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that, weather permitting, the Harrison Road bridge crossing the Sugar River in Winnebago County will be closed on Monday, July 25. The bridge is located between Shirland and Illinois 75.

The closure, which begins at 9 a.m., is necessary to inspect the bridge. Signing will be utilized to redirect traffic during the project, which is scheduled to be completed by 2 p.m.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
