## **E 1100<sup>th</sup> Street/130<sup>th</sup> Street over Interstate 172 to close for repairs beginning June 15**

**QUINCY** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced a bridge repair project near the Interstate 72/Interstate 172 interchange that will close E 1100<sup>th</sup> Street/130<sup>th</sup> Street beginning Wednesday, June 15.

Benefits from the project include an improved driving surface and increasing the durability of the bridge deck. Work is expected to be completed in early August.

No traffic will be permitted on E 1100<sup>th</sup> Street/130<sup>th</sup> Street between County Road 1103E and 340<sup>th</sup> Avenue during the road closure. Motorists should allow for extra travel time. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,500 miles of highway and 9 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Two included approximately \$5.2 billion of improvements statewide on 3,020 miles of highway, 270 bridges and 428 additional safety improvements.
