U.S. 34 work in Galesburg begins June 13

GALESBURG – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that pavement repairs on eastbound U.S. 34 between Main Street (Illinois 164) and Henderson Street (U.S. 150) in Galesburg begin June 13.

The work will require overnight lane closures and is expected to be complete by the end of the month. Motorists also can expect intermittent daytime lane closures for patching in the westbound lanes.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,500 miles of highway and 9 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Two included approximately \$5.2 billion of improvements statewide on 3,020 miles of highway, 270 bridges and 428 additional safety improvements.
