Illinois 2 repairs in Ogle County begin June 13

DIXON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that pavement patching has begun on Illinois 2 in Oregon in Ogle County. The work zone is from Pines Road south to the BNSF railroad bridge.

Work will take place through Tuesday, June 21. Traffic will be controlled by temporary traffic signals to maintain one lane of traffic through the work zone.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
