Work at Willow/Pfingsten intersection resumes

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that intersection improvements resume at Willow and Pfingsten roads, in Glenview, weather permitting, the week of March 28. To complete the work daytime lane closures will take place.

The \$1.4 million project will resurface and widen the intersection to allow for new right-turn lanes on Willow Road, install modernized traffic signals and construct new ADA-compliant sidewalk ramps. Work is anticipated to be completed in early August.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,535 miles of highway and 9 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Two included approximately \$5.2 billion of improvements statewide on 3,020 miles of highway, 270 bridges and 428 additional safety improvements.
