Grand Avenue resurfacing begins Monday

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that a patching and resurfacing of Grand Avenue, from Green Bay Road (Illinois 131) to the Amstutz Expressway (Illinois 137), in Waukegan, will require daytime, intermittent lane closures beginning, weather permitting, Monday, April 4.

The \$4.1 million project, which consists of resurfacing the 2.8-mile stretch of Grand Avenue, constructing new ADA-compliant sidewalk ramps and replacing deteriorated curbs, is expected to be completed by the end of the year. Access to residences and businesses within the work zone will be maintained throughout construction.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,535 miles of highway and nine million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Two included approximately \$5.2 billion of improvements statewide on 3,020 miles of highway, 270 bridges and 428 additional safety improvements.
