BRIDGE REPAIRS and HOT MIX ASPHALT RESURFACING
I-24
JOHNSON COUNTY

CARBONDALE-The Illinois Department of Transportation is alerting motorists traveling on I-24 in Johnson County of the upcoming two-year construction project beginning at 7 a.m. Monday, March 14th, weather permitting. Traffic will be reduced to one lane.

The project includes bridge repairs on multiple structures in each direction on I-24 from the structures over US 45 (Mile Post 14) to the Massac County Line at (Mile Post 24) and hot mix asphalt resurfacing.

All bridge work must be completed by November 22, 2022, and the entire project shall be completed by November 15, 2023.

Motorists should be aware of the 14'-3" width restriction, reduce speed, be alert for equipment and workers and use extreme caution while traveling through all work zones.

To avoid any delays, motorists should seek an alternate route. Emergency vehicles will be allowed through the work zone as quickly as possible.
