## **Work on Illinois 110/Illinois 336 in Adams and Hancock counties begins on May 6**

**QUINCY** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced the start of two micro-surfacing projects on Illinois 110/Illinois 336. The Adams County project will be located between U.S. 24 and just north of Illinois 61 near Mendon and begins Friday, May 6. The Hancock County project will be located about 3 miles east of Carthage to the McDonough County line and begins the week of May 9.

Traffic will be maintained using signs, cones and flaggers. One lane of traffic in each direction will remain open. The Adams County project is expected to be completed in mid-August. The Hancock County project is expected to be completed at the end of August.

These projects are part of IDOT's Transportation Asset Management Plan. These projects are intended to extend the lifespan of the existing driving surface to delay more costly pavement rehabilitation.

Traffic traveling to and from the Adams County Fair may be impacted. Motorists may experience delays and should allow extra time for trips through these areas. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
