## Bridge work to close U.S. 24 beginning May 16

**QUINCY** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced a bridge replacement project just north of 12<sup>th</sup> Street in Quincy that will close U.S. 24 beginning Monday, May 16.

The closure is necessary for a bridge replacement over Homan Creek. A posted detour will direct traffic to use Illinois 104 and Illinois 96. Work is expected to be completed by mid-September; however, U.S. 24 will open to traffic on Aug. 15, but lane closures will be necessary. Benefits from the project include restoring ride quality and increasing the durability of the bridge deck.

No traffic will be permitted on U.S. 24 between Spring Lake Drive/North 12<sup>th</sup> Street and North 12<sup>th</sup> Street during the road closure. Motorists are encouraged to follow the posted detour and should allow for extra travel time. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,500 miles of highway and 9 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Two included approximately \$5.2 billion of improvements statewide on 3,020 miles of highway, 270 bridges and 428 additional safety improvements.
