Cal Sag Road bridge repairs begin May 16

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that repairs to the bridge carrying Cal Sag Road (Illinois 83) over LaGrange Road (U.S. 45), in Palos Township, will require daily lane closures beginning, weather permitting, Monday, May 16.

The \$1.1 million project, which consists of removing the existing concrete median, structural concrete repairs, installation of a new deck overlay and approaches, is expected to be completed in October.

To complete the work daily lane closures will be required on Cal Sag Road and on LaGrange Road at the bridge.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,535 miles of highway and nine million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Two included approximately \$5.2 billion of improvements statewide on 3,020 miles of highway, 270 bridges and 428 additional safety improvements.
