Interstate 64 WB, Mascoutah, Illinois, St. Clair County

Mascoutah – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces lane closures on I-64 WB between IL 4 and Rieder Rd in Mascoutah. Beginning on Tuesday, May 31, 2022, the right lane will be closed. On Wednesday, June 1, 2022, the closure will change to the left lane through Friday, June 3, 2022, weather permitting.

These restrictions are needed to do deck repairs on the structure. IDOT District 8 Operations forces will make the needed improvements. Full access will be restored as soon as possible.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
