Centennial Bridge repairs in Rock Island begin May 12

DIXON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that, weather permitting, there will be lane closures on the U.S. 67 Mississippi River bridge (Centennial Bridge) in Rock Island on Thursday, May 12, for signing repairs.

There will be multiple lane closures on the bridge starting at 9 a.m. Work will begin in the northbound lanes before shifting to the southbound lanes. Temporary traffic signals and signing will be utilized to maintain traffic during the project, which is scheduled to be completed by 2 p.m.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
