## Construction on U.S. 52/Illinois 64 in Carroll County begins Sept. 19

**DIXON** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that weather permitting, construction will begin Monday, Sept. 19, on the culvert carrying U.S. 52/Illinois 64 over Middle Creek in Carroll County. The work zone is located about 6 miles east of Lanark.

Work will first widen the shoulder and perform other safety improvements around the culvert. There will be daytime lane closures during the work.

In early to mid-October, the road will be closed for five days to complete the culvert replacement. A marked detour will direct motorists to use Illinois 73, Illinois 72, Illinois 26 and Illinois 64. The project is expected to be completed by the end of November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 2,500 miles of highway and nearly 10 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Three of Rebuild Illinois included approximately \$8.6 billion of improvements statewide on 4,422 miles of highway, 412 bridges, and 621 additional safety improvements.
