Interstate 64 WB, West of Nashville, Washington County

Nashville, Illinois – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces lane restrictions will be encountered beginning today, September 06, 2022, through Monday, September 12, 2022, weather permitting, on I-64 westbound over Beaver Pond Creek, near mile marker 45.5, west of Nashville.

These restrictions are needed to complete repairs on the bridge structure. IDOT District 8 Operations forces will make the needed improvements. Full access will be restored as soon as possible.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
