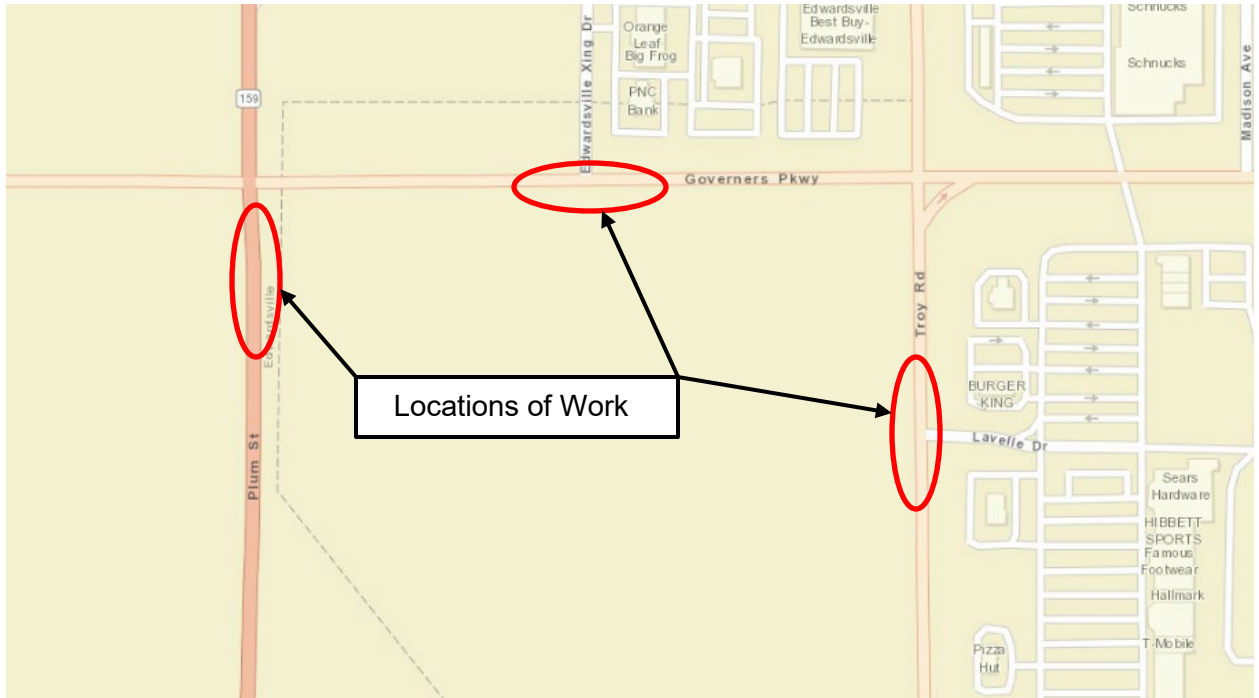
PRESS RELEASE – Lane Closures

*IL Route 159 (Plum Street)
Governor's Parkway
Old IL Route 159 (Troy Road)
Glen Carbon and Edwardsville, Illinois, Madison County*

Glen Carbon - The Illinois Department of Transportation announces daily lane closures will be encountered on IL Route 159 (Plum Street) from north of Center Grove Road to south of Governor's Parkway, on Governor's Parkway between IL 159 (Plum Street) and Old IL 159 (Troy Road) and on Old IL 159 (Troy Road) from north of Robinson Road to Governor's Parkway. Please see map on page 2. This work will start on Monday, October 3, 2022, extending through March 30, 2022. This work is necessary to complete turn lanes, intersection and signal improvements, and drainage reconstruction for the Orchards Town Center Development. Work is being completed by Keller Construction and Electrico, Inc.

Motorists may experience traffic congestion with delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
