Illinois 26 pavement patching in Freeport Sept. 30

DIXON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that, weather permitting, construction on Illinois 26 at South Street in Freeport will begin at 12 a.m. Friday, Sept. 30. Work will consist of pavement patching.

South Street will be closed at Illinois 26 during construction, and traffic on Illinois 26 will be reduced to one lane in each direction. Work is expected to be completed by 9 a.m. Friday, Sept. 30.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 2,500 miles of highway and nearly 10 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Three of Rebuild Illinois included approximately \$8.6 billion of improvements statewide on 4,422 miles of highway, 412 bridges, and 621 additional safety improvements.
