U.S. 20 work in Cherry Valley begins Nov. 9

DIXON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that, weather permitting, construction on eastbound U.S. 20 in Cherry Valley will begin on Wednesday, Nov. 9. The work zone will be in the left lane of eastbound U.S. 20 from Mill Road to a half-mile east of the Kishwaukee River bridge.

Work consists of full-depth pavement patching. A lane closure will be in place during the project, which is scheduled to be completed on Monday, Nov. 14.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
