Avenue G and 12th Avenue southbound lane between Sterling and Rock Falls closes April 24

DIXON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, the southbound lane on the Avenue G and 12th Avenue bridges crossing the Rock River between Sterling and Rock Falls will be closed starting Monday, April 24. Utility workers will be installing new facilities attached to the bridges.

The closure will affect motorists travelling from Sterling to Rock Falls. Northbound traffic from Rock Falls into Sterling will be able to use the bridges through the work zone. Access will be maintained to nearby residences, businesses, parks and schools during the work, which is anticipated to be completed by Friday, June 23.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
